Saint Benedict (480-547) after his death became extremely influential as his Rule came to be adopted in the majority of the monasteries of Western Christendom, Indeed. the early Middle Ages have been called "the Benedictine centuries." Late Pope Benedict XVI, stated: "With his life and work, Saint Benedict exercised a fundamental influence on the development of European civilization and culture" and helped Europe to emerge from the "dark night of history" that followed the fall of the Roman Empire. Beyond its religious influences, the Rule of Saint Benedict has been one of the most important written works in the shaping of Western society, embodying the idea of a written constitution, authority limited by law, and the right of the ruled to review the legality of the actions of their rulers. It also incorporated a degree of democracy in a non-democratic society. Benedict was named patron protector of Europe by Pope Paul VI in 1964. His feast day, previously March 21, was moved in 1969 to July 11, a date on which he was celebrated in many areas since the 8th century.

St. Benedict's Medal. On the front is a cross, containing the letters C S S M L - N D S M D, initials of the words Crux sacra sit mihi lux! Nunguam draco sit mihi dux! ('May the holy cross be my light! May the dragon never be my overlord!'). The large C S P B stand for Crux Sancti Patris Benedicti ('The Cross of [our] Holy Father Benedict'). Surrounding the cross on the medal are the letters V R SNSMV-SMQLIVB, in reference to Vade retro satana: Vade retro Satana! Numquam suade mihi vana! Sunt mala quae libas. Ipse venena bibas! ('Begone Satan! Never tempt me with your vanities! What you offer me is evil. Drink the poison yourself!') and finally, located at the top is the word PAX which means 'peace'.

In 1984 at the close of the Holy Year of Redemption, over 300,000 young people from around the world responded to the invitation of His Holiness John Paul Il for an International Jubilee of youth on Palm Sunday in St. Peter's Square. It was at this gathering that the Pope entrusted to the youth what is now known as the World Youth Day Cross, to be carried throughout the world as a symbol of the love of Christ for humanity. The following Palm Sunday, coinciding with the United Nation's International Year of the Youth, the Pope took the opportunity to welcome the vouth of the world to Rome again. Later, announcing the institution of World Youth Day on. 20th Dec. 1985, and the first official WYD was held in 1986 in Rome.
